Star of Hope



Bright colors!! Use bright colored fabrics, fabrics filled with color!! Block is 6 ½" unfinished.

Use 3 contrasting fabrics for the Star of Hope block.

A and B are one fabric.

C and E are one fabric.

D is one fabric.

## **Cut the following:**

- A: Cut  $4 2\frac{1}{2}$ "
- B: Cut  $1 3\frac{1}{4}$ ; cut square diagonally in 4, corner to corner
- C: Cut  $1 3\frac{1}{4}$ ; cut square diagonally in 4, corner to corner
- D: Cut 2 − 2 7/8"; cut square diagonally in 2, corner to corner
- E: Cut 1 2 ½"

## Sewing:

Sew scant 1/4" seams.



1. Sew B to C. Sew B/C to D. Sew B/C/D to A squares, one on either side. Press seams to outside.



2. Sew 2 - B/C/D sections to E. Press seams to inside.



3. Repeat Step 1. Press seams to outside.
