## Block of the Month

Due October 5, 2017

## Autumn Star



As the days get shorter, it signals the end of summer and the fast approaching season of autumn. Autumn Star uses all those warm colors you have in your stash. Block is $121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.

## Cut the following:

- Background fabric: Cut 4-4 $1 / 2$ " squares
- Background fabric: Cut $4-21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips
- Medium fabric (center): Cut $1-4 \frac{1}{2}$ " square
- Medium fabric (star points): Cut $8-21 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ squares
- Dark fabric: Cut $4-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips


## Sewing:

Sew scant $1 / 4$ " seams.
Creating flying geese:

- Place one medium fabric square on top of background fabric strip right sides together. Draw a diagonal line onto back of the square, pin and sew directly on line. Trim to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from sewn line. Press open to create one side of triangle. Repeat this process on the other side of triangle. Sew 4 units.
