"N" is for No-Name is the name of November's Block of the Month. The block only uses 2 fabrics, one light and one dark. Keeping with the 2018 Color of the Year, Ultra Violet, use this color in one of your fabric selections. Contrast, contrast, contrast to make the stairsteps pop.

Block is 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.

Cut the following:


1 light strip	2" x WOF
1 dark strip	2" x WOF

Sewing:

Using 1/4" seam allowance, sew the block with these easy-to-follow step-by-step instructions.



- 1. Sew two strips together. Press seam to dark fabric.
- Cut sewn strip into 9 3 ½" sections.
- 3. Lay out sections alternating direction of strips in all 3 rows.
- 4. Sew sections together in each row. Press seams alternating direction in each row so when rows are sewn together, seams will nest.



- 2. Sew row 1/2 to row 3.
- 3. Press seams open.

Does your block resemble the example? Do the stairsteps pop?
