"S" is for Scrappy



"S" is for Scrappy is the name of September's Block of the Month. Go to your stash (we all have one!), pick out a variety of fabrics with Ultra Violet or a shade of purple, prints and/or solids, lights, mediums and darks. It's easy, quick and fun! This simple and fun block allows you extra time to make several blocks.

Block is 9 ½" x 9 ½" unfinished.

Cut the following:

9 different fabrics
2 different fabrics
2 cut 9 - 1 ½" x 5 ½" strips
Cut 4 - 1 ½" x 9 ½" strips

Sewing:

Using 1/4" seam allowance, sew the block with these easy-to-follow step-by-step instructions.



- 1. Sew the 9-5 %" fabric strips together, mixing the lights, mediums and darks.
- 2. Press each seam open.



- 1. Sew 2 9 ½" fabric strips together. Sew a 2nd set.
- 2. Sew each set of 9 ½" strips to either side of 5 ½" strip unit.
- 3. Press each side seam towards outside of block.

It's that simple! Make another!
