## Santa Rosa Quilt Guild September 2018 Block of the Month Due October 4, 2018

"S" is for scrappy

" S " is for Scrappy is the name of September's Block of the Month. Go to your stash (we all have one!), pick out a variety of fabrics with Ultra Violet or a shade of purple, prints and/or solids, lights, mediums and darks. It's easy, quick and fun! This simple and fun block allows you extra time to make several blocks.

Block is $91 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.
Cut the following:

- 9 different fabrics

Cut $9-1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips

- 2 different fabrics

Cut 4-1 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips

## Sewing:

Using $1 / 4$ " seam allowance, sew the block with these easy-to-follow step-by-step instructions.


1. Sew the $9-5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ fabric strips together, mixing the lights, mediums and darks.
2. Press each seam open.

3. Sew 2-9 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ fabric strips together. Sew a $2^{\text {nd }}$ set.
4. Sew each set of $91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to either side of $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip unit.
5. Press each side seam towards outside of block.

It's that simple! Make another!
