

# Santa Rosa Quilt Guild Block-of-the-Month April 2020 <br> "The (razy TULIP" 

## Cutting Instructions:

White Tone-on-Tone: Tulip Colored Fabric: Green Tone-on-Tone: Yellow Tone-on-Tone:

2-2-1/8" square*
1-1-1/2" square
$1-1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle
2-3" squares
2-2-1/2" squares

1-3" square
1-2-1/2" square
1-2-1/2" square

1-1-1/2" square

## Sewing Instructions:

1. Sew the yellow $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square to the white $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Sew the white 1 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ white rectangle above the first unit with the yellow to the left.

2. Draw a diagonal on $2-3$ " white squares. Layer right sides together with the $3^{\prime \prime}$ tulip colored and the $3^{\prime \prime}$ green. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on either side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line, press to dark. Trim to $2-2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ blocks.
3. To make the stem, draw a diagonal on the $2-2-1 / 8$ " white squares and sew to either side of the $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ green square as shown. Trim the excess
 green and white triangle from the back. Stem will be $1 / 2$ " wide.
4. Trim all squares to $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
5. Lay out and sew as shown in the last picture.
6. Unfinished block is $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
