

## Santa Rosa Quilt Guild Block-of-the-Month February 2020 "HEARTS A FLUTUTER"

## Cutting Instructions:

White Fabric:

1-4-1/2" square
2-3" squares

Darker Red Fabric:

6-2-1/2" squares
1-2-1/2" x 6-1/2"
1-3" square

Lighter Red Fabric:

5-2-1/2" squares
1-2-1/2" x 6-1/2"
1-3" square

## Sewing Instructions:

1. From 5-2-1/2" square darker red and 4-2-1/2" square lighter red fabrics, make a nine-patch.
2. Draw a diagonal line on the 2 white 3 " squares.
3. Place one marked white square face side together with one darker red and one lighter red square.
4. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from both sides of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line
 which makes 2 half square triangles (HST) of each. Press to darker side. Trim each HST to 2-1/2" square.
5. Sew each $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece to the top and side of the nine patch, matching color as shown.
6. Sew HST's to each side of the matching 2-1/2" square. Sew to the matching $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece. (Note, the HST in the upper right corner of the picture is incorrect.)

7. Assemble block with the white $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square piece in the corner.
8. Block should measure $10-1 / 2$ " square.
