Easter Bonnet

This block measures 12 1/2 unfinished.

Background (light)

B.- 4 ea. 2 1/2 " square OR whatever you need to make 4 half square triangles (HST)

D.- 2 ea. 2 1/2" by 6 1/2" (side of bonnet)

E.- 2 ea. 2 1/2" by 12 1/2" (top and bottom)

Bonnet

A. 14 ea. 2 1/2" squares (4 are used to make the HST)

C. 1 ea. 2 1/2" by 8 1/2" (row 3 of bonnet)



An embellishment can be added to C either before or after the bonnet is made depending on what you added

Instructions

- 1. Make 4 HST using the background fabric and the bonnet fabric. There are numerous techniques, use the one you're most comfortable using making sure the result is a 2 1/2 inches
- 2. Make row 1 of the bonnet with 2 of the HST and 2 A's. See picture. Row 2 are 4 A's and Row 3 is C. Sew row 1, 2 and 3 together.
- 3. Sew D to each side of the bonnet.
- 4. Sew row 4 with 2 of the HST and 4 A's together as shown. Sew this row to the bonnet.
- 5. Add E to the top and bottom of your bonnet, add your embellishments if so desired and now go outside and join the Easter Parade!
