"Pom Pom Cap"

We're still in the throes of winter ... tough life here in Sonoma County.

This month you'll be making a cap to pair up with the scarf BoM you made for January. And since it's February, the theme will be "Valentine's Day." So dig out that heart fabric you have stashed and only use once a year.

Just have fun with this quick block ... and stay warm!



Cutting Instructions: (see photo 1)

Background (white or light): Pom Pom:

A - 4 ea. 1-1/2" squares E - 1 ea. 4" square

B - 2 ea. 3-1/2" squares **Hat Body:**

C - 2 ea. 2-1/2" x 4" F - 1 ea. 7" x 8"

D - 2 ea. 2-3/4" x 12-1/2" **Bottom:**

G - 1 ea. 2-1/2" x 8"

Sewing Instructions:

- Draw a diagonal on the A and B pieces. Sew on the diagonal. Sew A on each corner of E.
 Trim and press toward the outside. Sew two B to F. Trim and press toward the hat.
- 2. Sew G to F. Sew a C to each side of E.
- 3. Sew E to F.
- 4. Sew D to both sides of the block.


Unfinished block is 12-1/2" square.
