

"Dress for Success"

May 2021 Block-of-the-Month (BOM)

12-1/2" block (unfinished)

Light Background:

- A: 1 3" square to make 2 2" Half-Square Triangles (HST) (collar)
- C: 1 3" square to make 2 2-1/2" HST (sleeves)
- E: 4 1-1/2" squares (waistline for the top and skirt of the dress)
- H: 2 1 x 1-1/2" rectangles (belt)
- K: 2 2-1/2 x 9-1/2" rectangles (sides attached under sleeves)
- L: 1 1-1/2 x 9" rectangle (top of the block)
- M: 2 $2-1/2 \times 12-1/2$ " rectangles (sides of the block)

Contrast:

- B: 1 3" square to make 2 2" HST (collar)
- I: 1 1 x 3" rectangle (belt)

Dress:

- D: 1 3" square to make 2 2-1/2" HST (sleeves)
- J: 2 1-1/4 x 2" rectangles (shoulders)
- F: 1 3-1/2 x 5" rectangle (top of dress)
- G: 1 6-1/2 x 5" rectangle (skirt)



- Make 2 HSTs for collar by drawing a diagonal line on the light background A. Place right sides together (RST) with
 B. Stitch ¼" each side of drawn line. Cut on drawn line. Trim HST to 2". Press away from background fabric.
 Stitch the 2 HSTs together according to the photo. Press the seam OPEN. Stitch a J to each side of the HST unit.
 Press towards the J rectangles.
- 2. Make 2 HSTs for sleeves by drawing a diagonal line on the light background C. Place RST with D. Stitch ¼" each side of drawn line. Cut on drawn line. Trim to 2-1/2". Press to sleeve.
- 3. Make the waistline for the top and the skirt by drawing diagonal lines on each of the four E 1-1/2" squares, placing two at the bottom of the top F and two at the top of the skirt G (refer to photo for placement). Sew on drawn line. Trim ¼" from sewn line. Press away from the background fabric.
- 4. Make belt by stitching an H square to each side of the I rectangle. Press away from the background fabric
- 5. Stitch the collar unit to the top. Press toward the top.
- 6. Stitch that unit to the belt. Press toward the top.
- 7. Stitch that unit to the skirt. Press toward the skirt.
- 8. Stitch the sleeve HSTs to the K rectangles according to the photo. Press towards the background Ks.
- 9. Stitch the sleeve units to the dress unit. Press towards the dress.
- 10. Stitch the L rectangle to the top of the dress. Press towards L.
- 11. Stitch the M rectangles to each side. Press towards the M background fabrics.
- 12. Trim to 12-1/2".
- 13. Sign the block on the front or back.
