CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS: (Figure 2)

White or off-white background: Color fabrics:

12 ea. 2-1/2" squares (1) **Color A, B, C and D**

4 ea. 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles (2) 1 ea. 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle (3)

1 ea. 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle (4)

Contrasting color

4 ea. 2-1/2" squares (5)



SEWING INSTRUCTIONS:

Unit 1

- 1. Sew four contrasting color squares (5) to four white background squares (1). (Figure 3)
- 2. Sew joined squares to one white 4-1/2" rectangle (2). The color portion should be on the upper left.

Unit 2

- 1. Draw a corner-to-corner diagonal line on 4 white squares (1). With right sides together, place one square at the top of one of the 4-1/2" rectangles (4) with the line going down from left to right.
- 2. Stitch on the line and trim 1/4" toward the top.
- 3. Press toward the darker fabric.
- 4. Repeat for the three remaining sets of squares and 4-1/2" rectangles. (Figure 4)

Note: Before sewing sections together, lay out all the pieces of the block so that you are sure to get the colors placed correctly to get the woven effect. (Figure 5)

Unit 3

- 1. Sew Unit 1 to Unit 2 with the color portions together to make Unit 3.
- 2. Repeat for the remaining units 1 and 2.
- 3. Press to the darker fabric. (Figure 7)



Unit 4

- 1. Repeat the process for remaining squares and the 6-1/2" rectangles. (Figure 7).
- 2. Sew unit #3 to unit #4. Press seam to the darker fabric. Repeat for the remaining #3 and #4 units. (Figure 8)

Assemble the four sections with the colors in the center to make the woven pattern. Sew two together, and then the remaining two. Join the two sections to have the completed block. (Figure 9)

Square the completed block to 12-1/2". (Figure 1)

Please write your name on a back side seam of each block you submit and, we'll fill out a ticket(s) to enter you into the *drawing*, to be held on January 5. Bring your blocks to Rena or Kay at our meetings, or to Village Sewing Center, mail them to us, or contact us to arrange for pickup. Hope you have as much fun choosing fabrics and color combinations as we did when assembling this block.
