# "Ohio Star"

#### **CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:**

White or off-white fabric

- 2 ea. 5" squares
- 2 ea. 5-1/2" squares

#### Color fabric

- 2 ea. 5" squares (same or contrasting colors)
- 2 ea. 5-1/2" squares
- 1 ea. 4-1/2" square (center block)

#### **SEWING INSTRUCTIONS:**

#### Assemble four hour glass blocks using 5-1/2" squares

#### Layer one color square and one background square, right sides together.

- 1. Draw a diagonal line, corner to corner, on wrong side of background square.
- 2. Sew 1/4" on both sides of line.
- 3. Cut on the drawn line.
- 4. Press to color side.

## Layer two halves of the cut block, right sides together, background to color.

- 1. Draw a diagonal line, corner to corner, on wrong side of block.
- 2. Sew 1/4" on both sides of line, cut on the drawn line.
- 3. Open block and press.
- 4. Align corners and square up to 4-1/2".

#### Assemble four half-triangle blocks using 5" squares

#### Layer one color square and one background square, right sides together.

- 1. Draw a diagonal line, corner to corner, on wrong side of background square.
- 2. Sew 1/4" on both sides of line, cut on drawing line. Open block and press to color side.
- 3. Square up to 4-1/2".

Arrange the nine blocks as shown above, and sew them into a 12-1/2" block.

*Note*: Please write your name on a backside seam of your 12-1/2" block(s) in order to be entered into the drawing, and submit to a Block-of-the-Month Chairperson.
