CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

White or off-white background:

2 ea. 6-3/4" squares 4 ea. 2-1/2" squares

4 ea. 2-1-2" x 4-1/2" rectangles

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. On wrong side of the 6-3/4" background squares, draw two diagonal lines (x).
- 2. Place one background square on to each color A square, right sides together.
- 3. Sew 1/4" on both sides of both lines (x).
- 4. Cut in half top to bottom and left to right (+).
- 5. Then cut on diagonal lines (x) to make a total of 16 half-square triangles.
- 6. Press the half-square triangles to the color side and square up each one to 2-1/2" using the diagonal line on your ruler.
- 7. Arrange the Color A, 16 half-square triangles, per the finished block. (Picture 1)
- 8. Place Color B, $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square in center, per the finished block.
- 9. Place Color B, 2-1/2" square blocks at each corner of the center block, per the finished block.



Color fabrics: Color A (Half-square Triangles) 2 ea. 6-3/4" squares Color B (Squares) 1 ea, 4-1/2" square 4 ea. 2-1/2" squares
