Opportunity Quilt 1997-1998

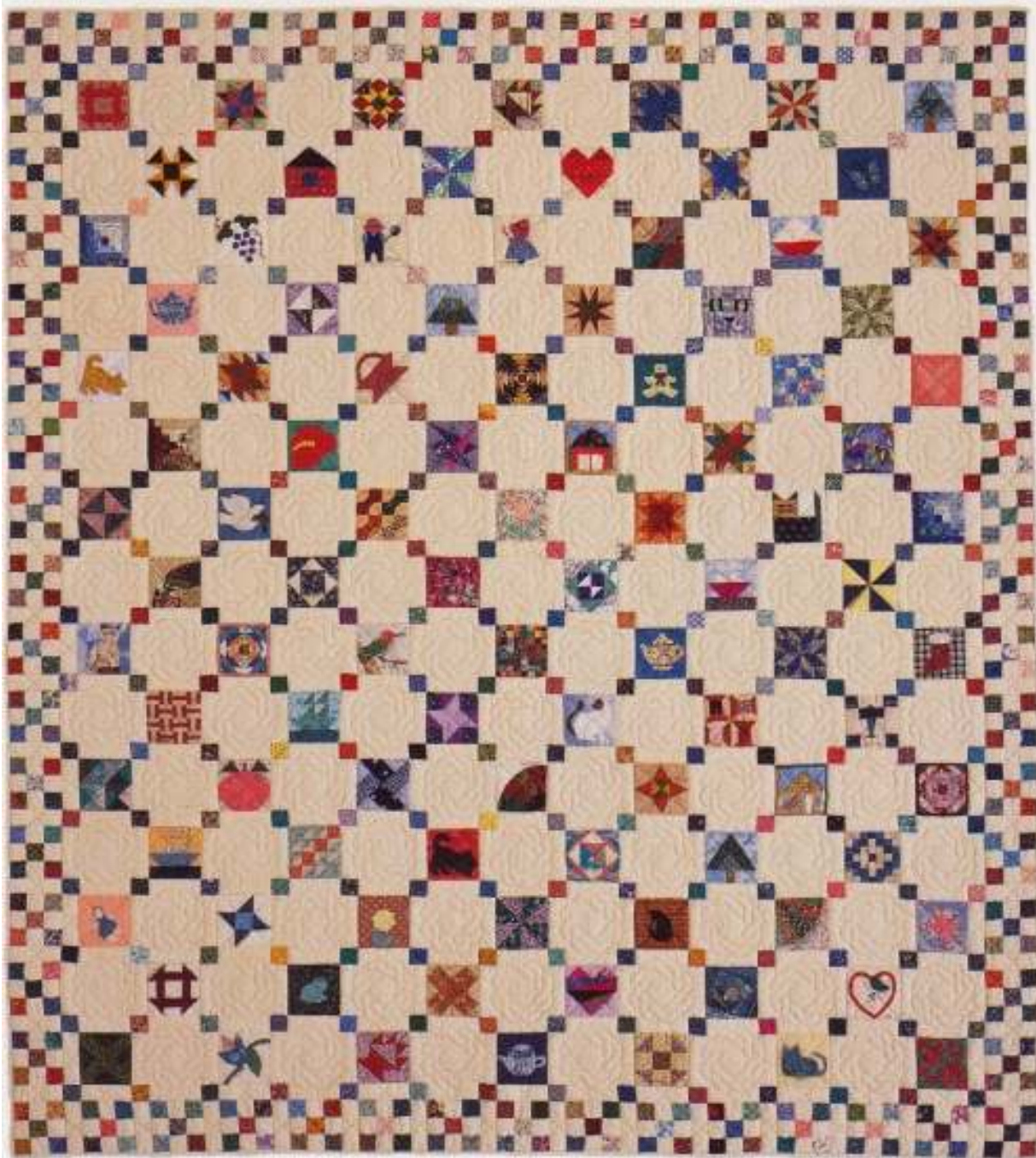
Name: Little Treasures (77" x 87")
